A note on this booklet

This booklet contains the lyrics for all the songs in the show.

It also includes a brief description of the mood and feeling of each song, to convey the non-lyrical elements for D/deaf and hard-of-hearing audiences.

While I have tried my best to show exactly what I sing for each song, there may be times when I add in extra vocalisations (singing sounds like 'ooh' or 'ah') that aren't written here. These sounds help me build up the mood of the song as I'm performing it.

Please note the lyrics of 'Reason to Doubt' briefly allude to self-harm.

Please note 'Fundamental' contains swearing.

Song name: Appointment

Song description: This song has a moody, jazzy feeling. Ilana starts singing in a low tone, rises to higher notes, and then drops down again. The melody gives the feeling of anger rising and falling.

Song name: What A Lie

Song description: This song has a boppy, upbeat feeling, with a more drawn-out melody in the chorus. Multiple recordings of Ilana's voice come in as a group at the start of the song and in the chorus, representing the questions going round and round in her head.

Song description: This song is based around the 'oh, oh,' melody llana has been singing throughout the show so far. It is sad and thoughtful. The melody becomes higher in the chorus, representing the intensity of llana's feelings.

Song description: This song is split into two sections: a vintage style introduction, and an upbeat main section. Overall, the song is fun and cheeky. Ilana performs this song in a playful, sarcastic way.

Song description: A reprise is a section of a song that is repeated. This section sounds the same as Reason to Doubt, which was played earlier in the show.
